
Is the Great Commission time-sensitive? Are we on a time clock – should we hurry?

Creating an Environment for Christ's Return (Matthew 24:14)


- Preach to every nation



B. A local church and vision.

The local church must seek God for a strategy for fulfilling the vision.

This is a faith issue

God will not open a door of opportunity until the church is poised to walk through it.

C. Peter and Jerusalem modeled *Partnerships*


Acts 8:5,14

- Honor the giftings God has appointed


New Testament Church Partnerships




The Sovereign Role of the Local Church In Ministry Endeavors
